

JOB OPPORTUNITY: MURALIST

WE ARE LOOKING FOR AN ARTIST TO PAINT A NEW HERITAGE MURAL AT THE ENTRANCE TO ASHLEY DOWN STATION

Brief: The mural will portray the heritage of Ashley Down, with references to the previous railway history and connections to local sports' grounds. It will promote sustainable transport and highlight cycling routes around the station. The design will incorporate elements of nature and rewilding, and will represent the multigenerational and multicultural community of the area. The artist will spend time researching and connecting with the community to influence the design. The launch coincides with Railway 200, celebrating 200 years of the Railways.

Specifications: The artwork will be locally focused therefore we are keen to work with an artist with strong Bristol roots and understanding of the area.

Work must be completed by mid September 2025. The wall is 24.4m in length, with variable height along the length but all under 2m.

Fee: Artist fee is up to £3,250 for materials (including paints, primers and AG varnish), research, design and painting time.
